The men are always in black. The women always wear long skirts. Who are these unique people? They are called the Amish. The Amish people's life has changed very little for 400 years. They live together in Pennsylvania in the USA, have their own churches, and travel with horses and carriages. Their children never study again in school after they finish the eighth grade.
