The filename must follow this format: **Surname_SchoolAcronym** (Example: If the student's surname is Lee and from Sunflower Trilingual School, the file should be named Lee_STS). Partner schools may submit multiple essays under each theme.

All participating students will receive a **digital certificate of participation**, and we will compile the submissions into a **Global Classroom Digital Book**, showcasing the voices of young writers worldwide.
